- Concessions:** I produce foods for consumption at the market. Additional fees apply.
- Arts, Crafts & Services:** I produce arts, crafts or render services at the market. Space is limited. Diversity encouraged.

Priority is given to those who can commit to the full market season in Crested Butte.

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Additional paperwork requirements. Please review the additionally required paperwork and submit them with your application. If you are unable to submit required paper work, please submit a brief letter informing CBFM as to why you're unable to submit the paperwork at the time of application and when you anticipate having your paperwork complete. All paperwork must be in order by June 1st, 2012.

AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS:

- Documentation of Growing Practices such as organic certification, certified naturally grown documentation or statement on growing practices. For all new applications, CBFM will be in touch to schedule a farm tour. (ALL AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS)
- Egg License for those selling eggs. (ONLY THOSE SELLING EGGS)
- Dealer License such as small volume or farm products dealer for anyone reselling farm products to the public. (ONLY THOSE WHO INTEND TO APPLY TO RESELL ITEMS)

CONCESSIONS / VALUE-ADDED FOODS:

- Licenses and documentation issued by the Colorado Health Department such as documentation of your commercial kitchen, your retail food establishment license or your temporary retail food establishment license. (ALL VENDORS SELLING VALUE-ADDED FOODS, READY-TO-EAT FOODS OR CONCESSIONS)
- Signed concessions/value-added foods agreement see attached.

NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS:

- Documentation of not-for-profit status.

ALL VENDORS:

- Insurance / Waiver of Liability Form.
- \$50 non-refundable application fee. If accepted, your \$50 application fee will be applied toward your booth fees. Upon acceptance, we will issue you an invoice for your booth fees less your application fee. (NOT-FOR-PROFITS ARE EXCLUDED FROM THIS FEE)
- State of Colorado Business License / Sales Tax License.

- Please contact me about a payment plan for my booth fees. Those who pay their booth fees within 30 days of the invoice are given a 10% discount. If you need more time, we can set up a payment plan with you privately.

Concessions/Value-added Foods Statement

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The customers at the Crested Butte Farmers Market expect the value-added foods and concessions sold at the market to be prepared using the highest quality organic, local ingredients. As such, we expect you to adhere to the following requirements in sourcing your ingredients. Failure to abide by these recommendations could result in dismissal from the market.

- I understand the ingredients used in my prepared foods and concessions must be sourced locally (defined as Colorado) if I am using meat (beef, bison, elk, chicken or pork), eggs or fruit and vegetables (when said fruits or vegetables are in season) and honey.
- I understand that any fish or shellfish I use in my prepared foods and concessions must be sourced sustainably as defined as a “Best Choice” or “Good Alternative” rating by the Monterey Bay Aquarium’s Seafood Watch Program (seafoodwatch.org).
- I understand that any ingredients I use that are not sourced in Colorado must be USDA-certified organic.
- I understand that the following ingredients must always be USDA-certified organic: corn and corn products, cottonseed oils, soy and soy products, sugar, crookneck squash, papaya, potatoes, tomatoes, milk and milk products, meat and meat products, canola and canola products, rice, flax, chicory/radicchio, wheat and wheat products, vegetable oil.
- I understand that electricity is not provided by the Crested Butte Farmers Market, and I am not permitted to plug into neighboring businesses or homes unless I can provide CBFM with documentation of current ownership or lease of the property. Battery packs, self-contained systems encouraged.
